



# Editor's Foreword by Tab Kimpton

We get the word from Hermaphroditus, the son of the gods Hermes and Aphrodite, who was portrayed in ancient art as having a female figure and male genitals. We now know that sex is much more beyond the bits on the outside, so Intersex was coined in the 1920s.

#### Are intersex people trans/gay?

Some of them are, some aren't, just like everyone else. Intersex people are often included in LGBT but face different problems such as invasive doctors and non-consensual surgery on their genitals as children . . . just because adults want to be able to put either M or F on a birth certificate.

But surely doctors know best?



# DRAG LEGENDS QUEENS, KINGS AND PANTOMIME DAMES

Drag has a long history in entertainment-from Shakespeare plays where the female roles were played by men, to the British pantomime dame.

Drag is about exaggerated performance of gender roles, often using makeup, wigs, heels, padding and a LOT of glitter to create looks

Many drag artists create stage personas that they embody while in drag. Drag queens are usually referred to as 'she' and 'he' for Kings

Outside of drag people can be male, female, trans, nonbinary, gay, lesbian, bisexual, heterosexual, asexual... basically anything!

The reasons and style of drag depend on the creature doing it: from fun and fucking with gender, to comedy and creating awareness around important causes







## ACTIVISM

Activism is an important part of queer history because homosexuality was, and still is illegal in many places

Historically many of the minorities in this book have been lumped together under 'Gay rights'

#### THE GAY AGENDA

- \* Changing laws to gain equal rights

- \* Increasing social acceptance
- \* Airing out dirty laundry

But bisexual, trans and particularly transfeminine people have been swept under the rug to make it look more 'normal'

For some reason people who break traditional gender roles are very scary to society

Activism is about showing people that there is nothing wrong with being a minority monster, and that creatures of ALL kinds deserve respect, even if you don't understand them.


Bisexuals are attracted to their own gender AND to genders not their own (See pages 9-10)
