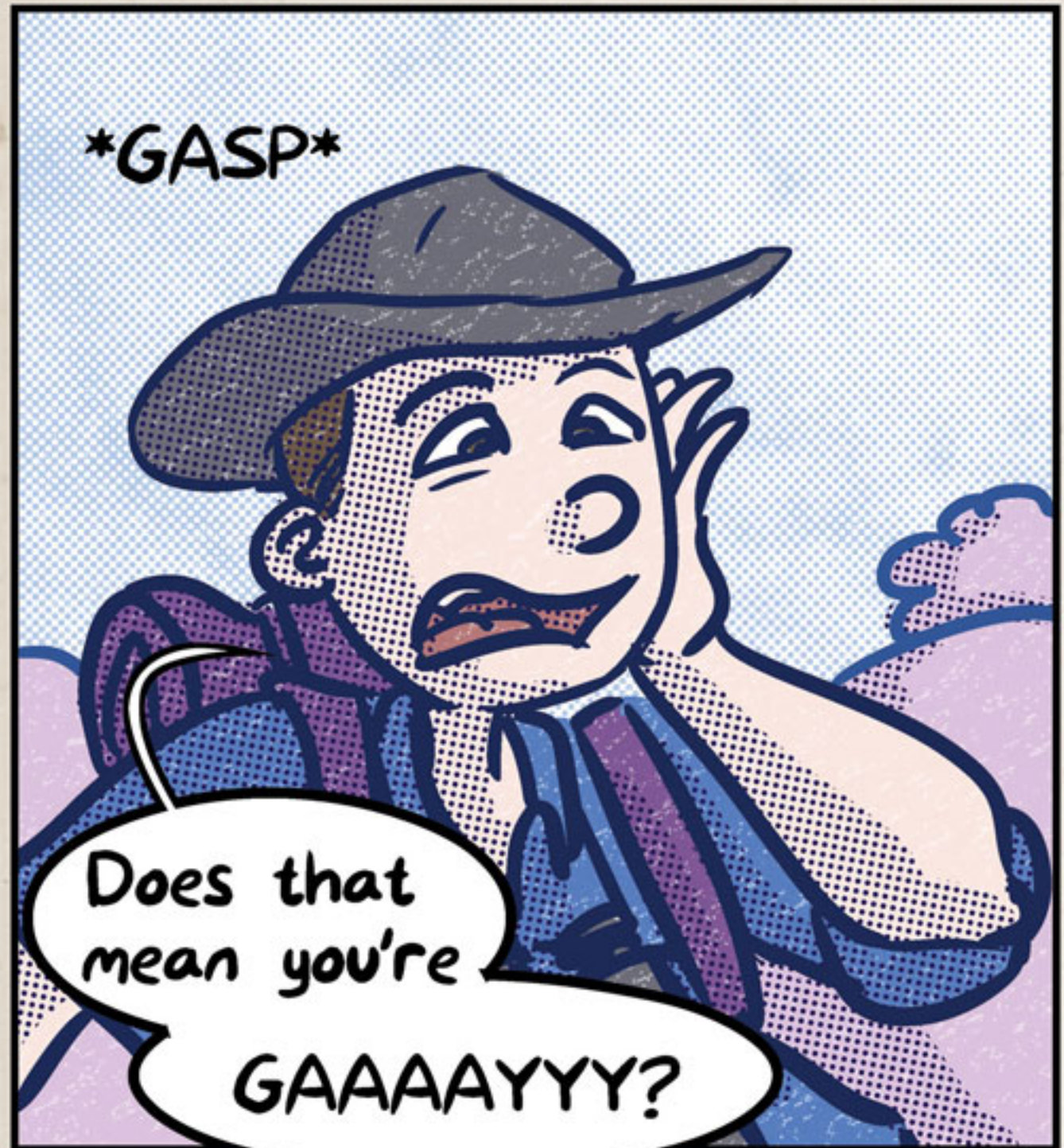
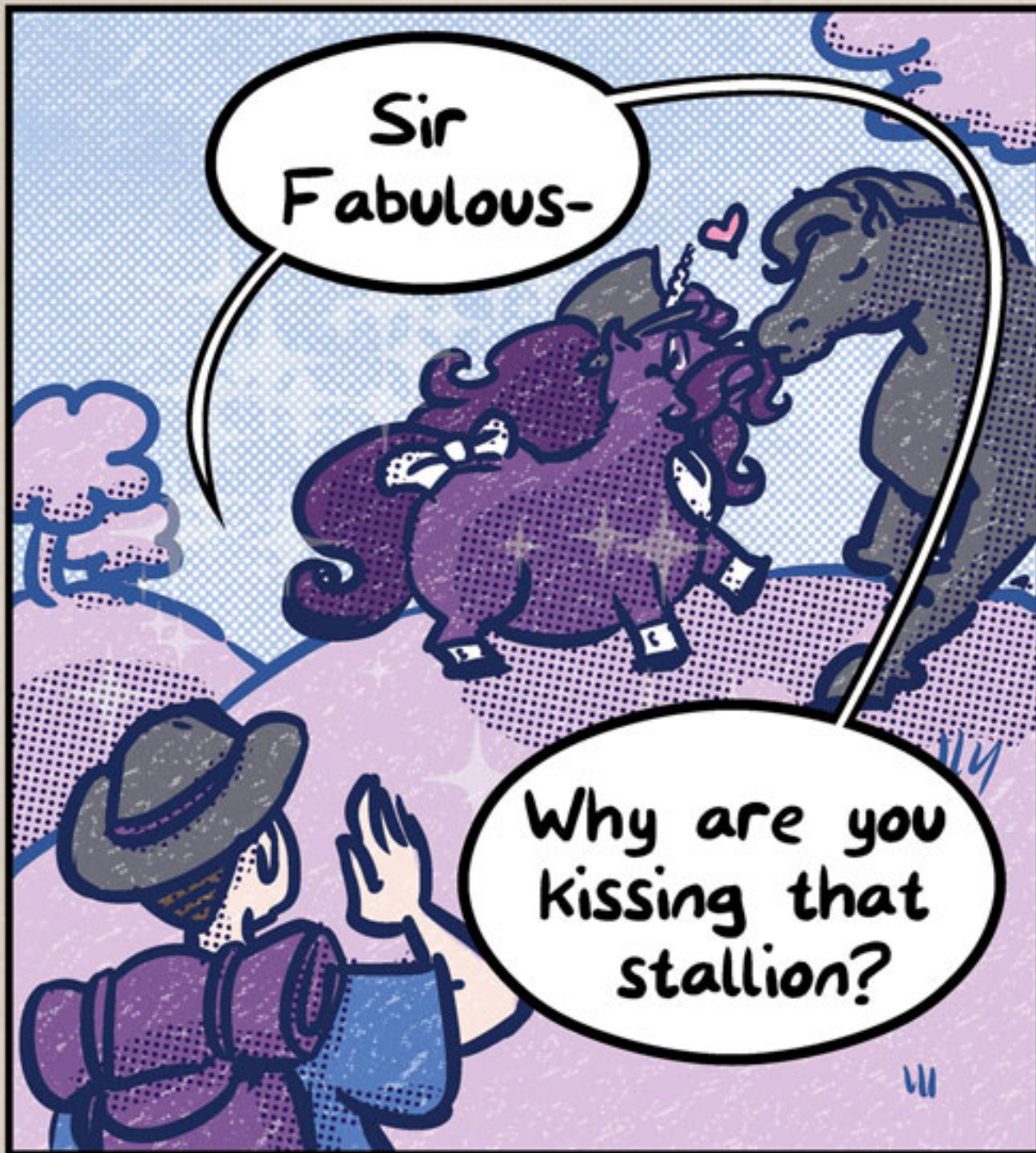

Luxurious hair to attract partners of many genders

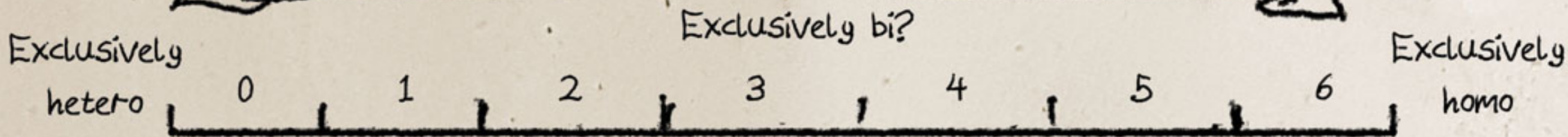
Bubble pipe (Part of the sparkle magic?)

\* Bisexuals will never commit to one partner because they always need to date someone of each gender

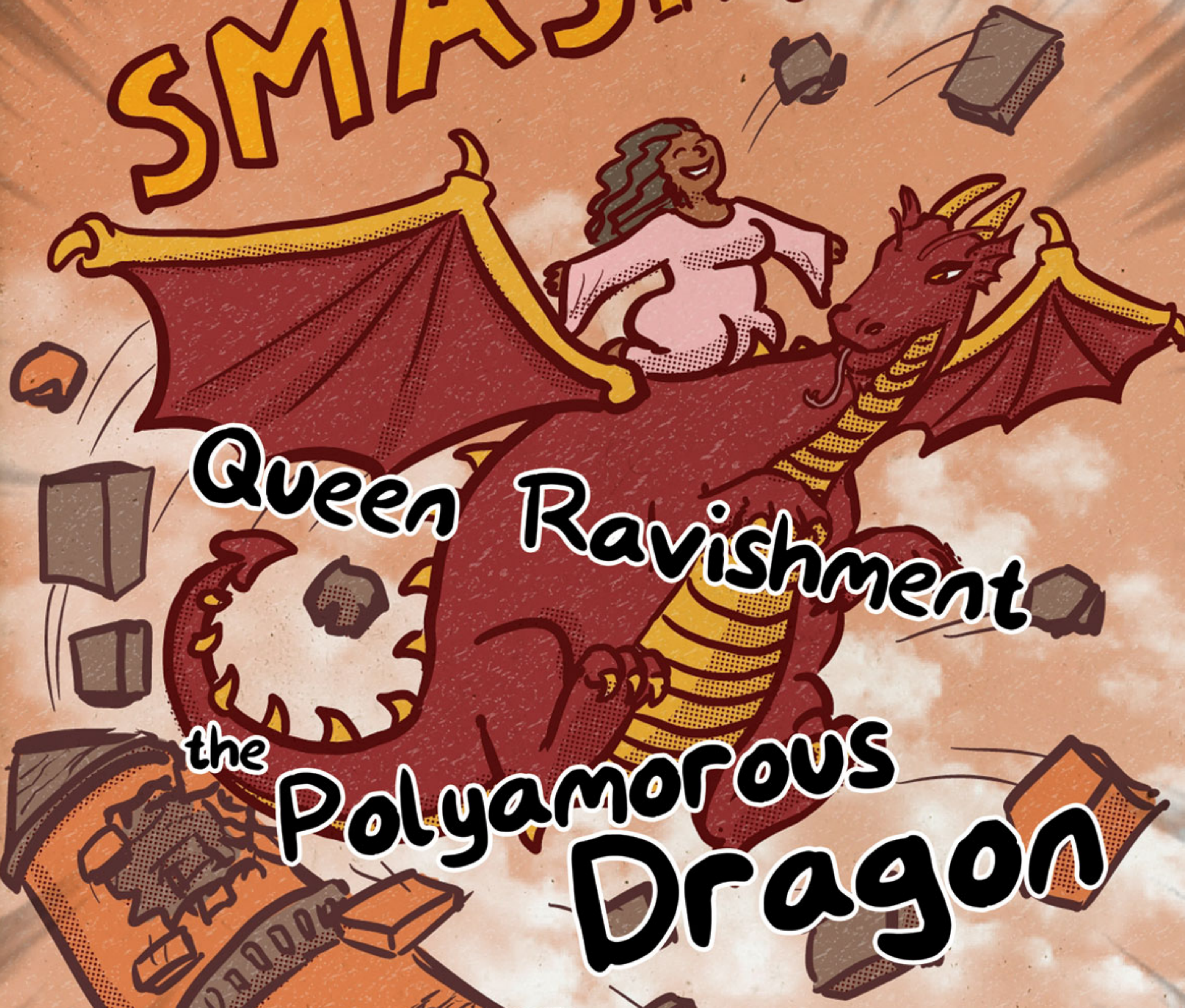

Like the Dryad Triad

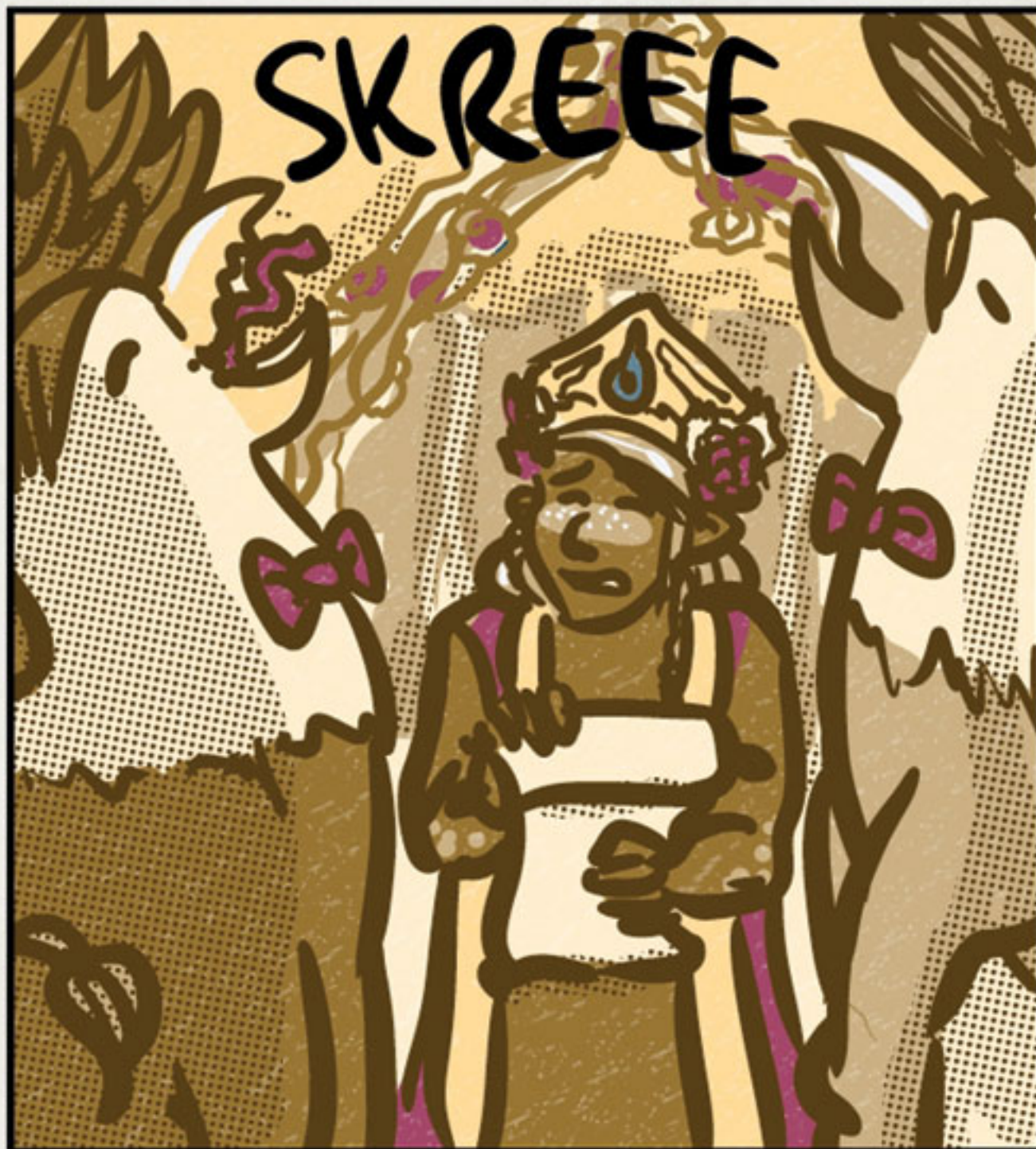


Some have a Don't ask, Don't tell policy with partners, some need to know more details.

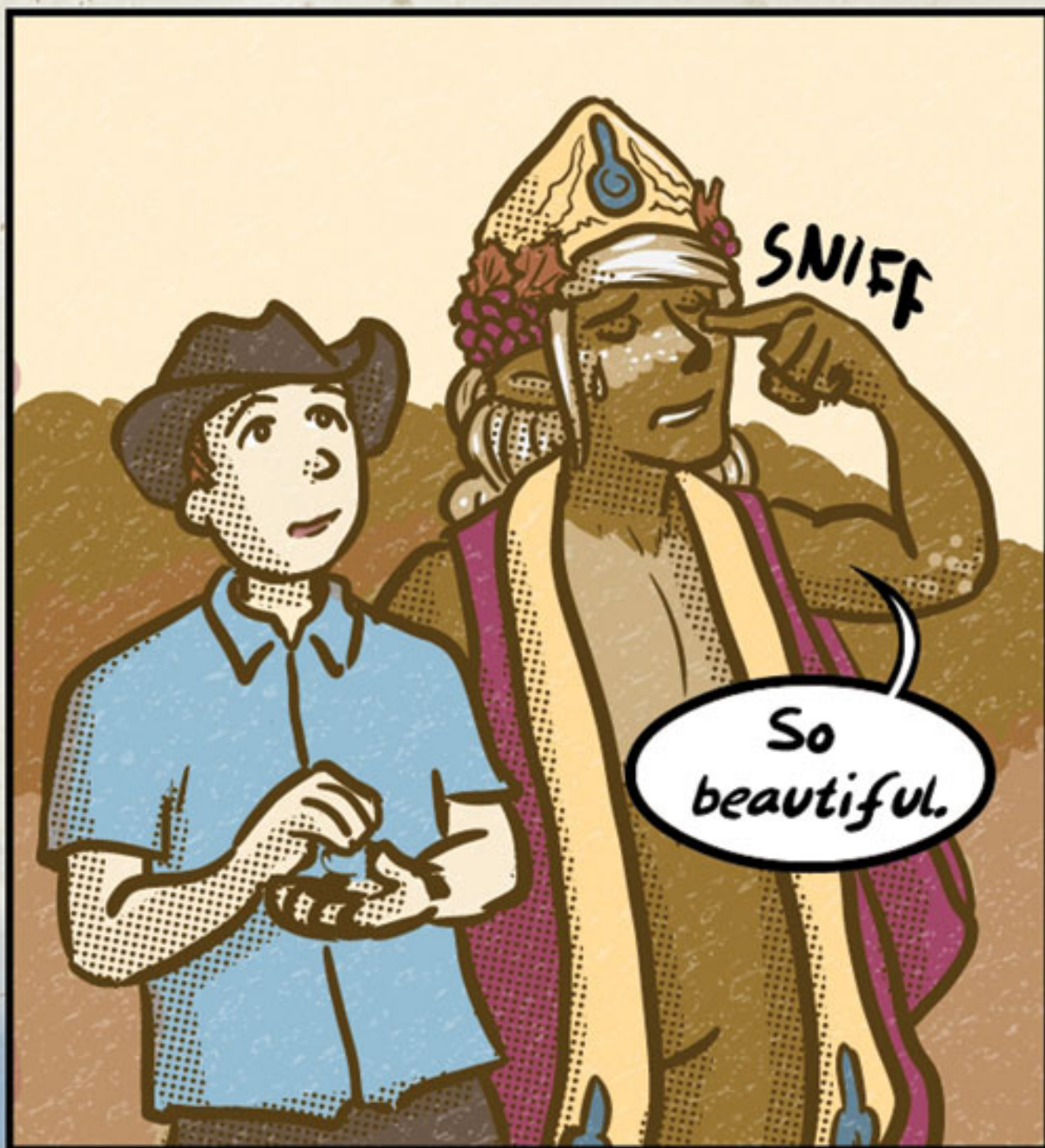


The Poly Symbol of Infinity

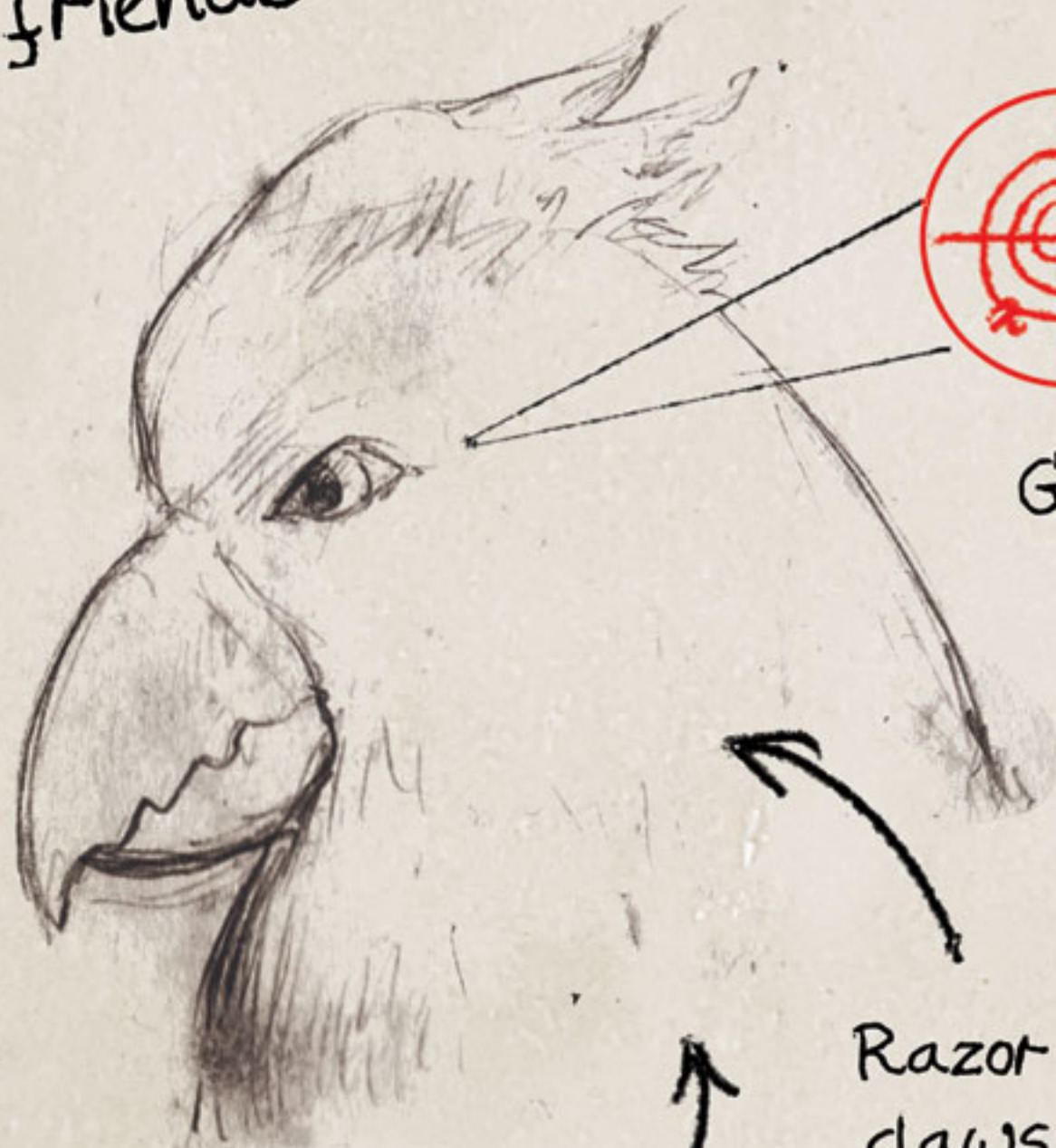


# HOMOSEXUAL (OR GAY GRIFFINS)

Someone attracted to people the same gender as themselves. But more than friends-like, in a GAY way.

A mix of sexual, romantic and social behaviour.

Gay has come to mean much more than just who you like to have sex with.



Gaydar to spot fellow Fliets  
(Magical properties as gay creatures don't really look or act alike)

Fluffy down for fluffy feelings of same sex romance

Razor sharp beak and claws to protect from DISCRIMINATION





# HETEROFLEXIBLE

(NOT-QUITE-STRAIGHT HIPPOGRIFFS)

Generally heterosexual but with the occasional exception

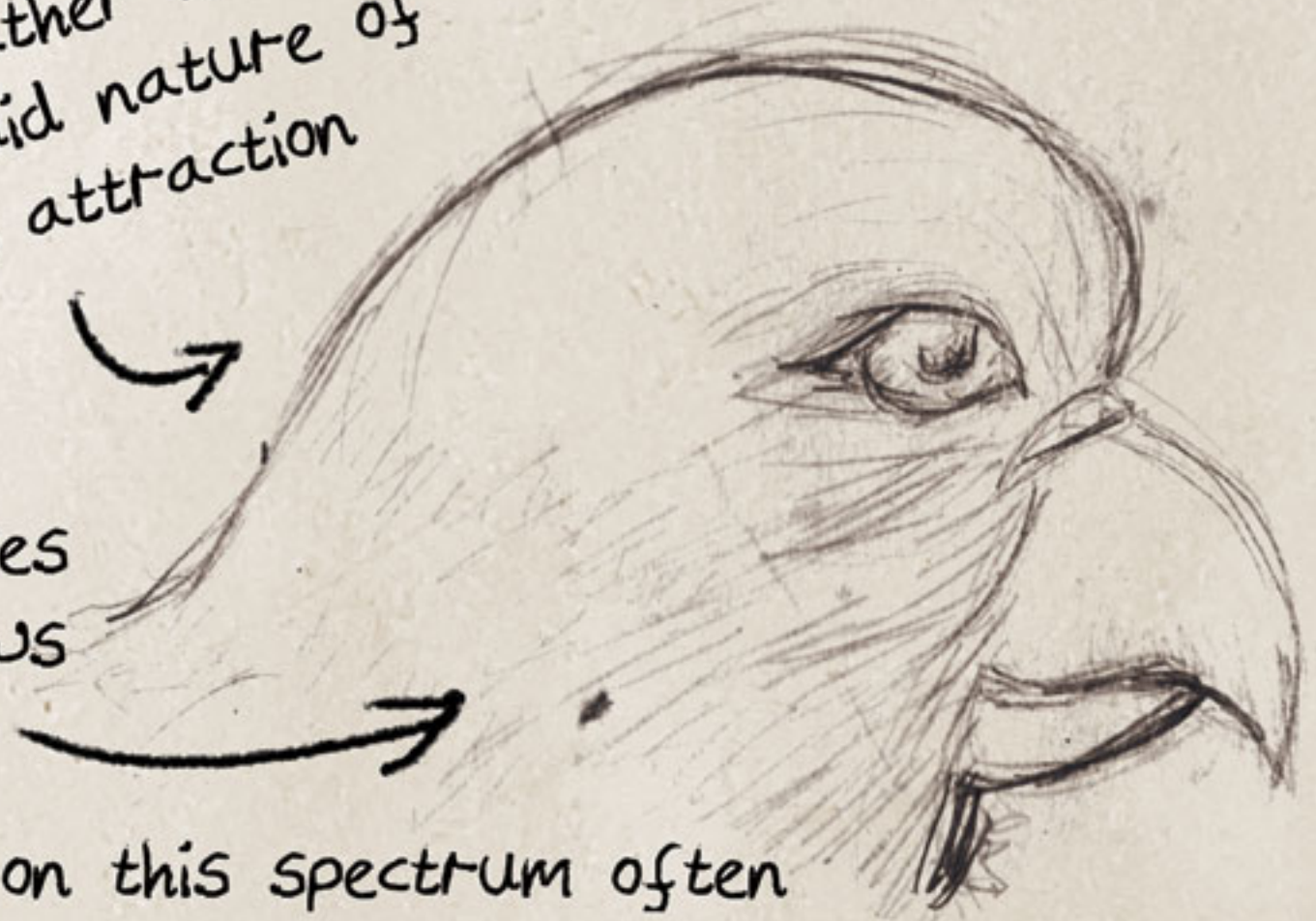
Sometimes you just find a fellow bird of a feather!

On a similar spectrum as the Homoflexible Hippocampus

Sleek feather lines to show fluid nature of sexual attraction

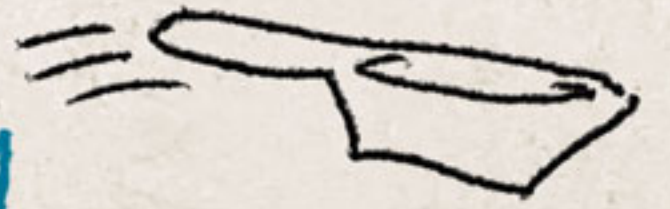

# PANSEXUAL



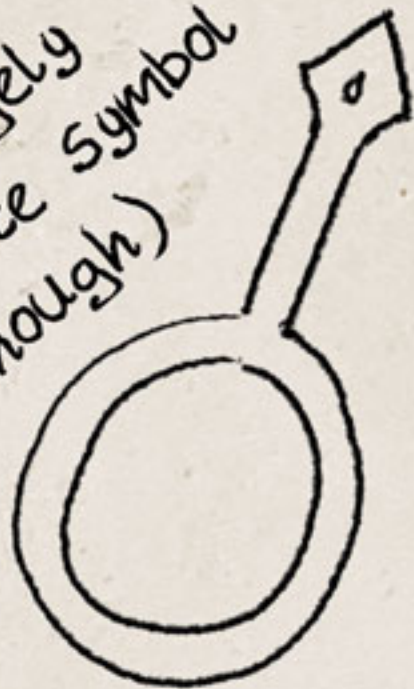
(SATYRS, SATYRESSES AND FAUNS)

This doesn't change who they are.

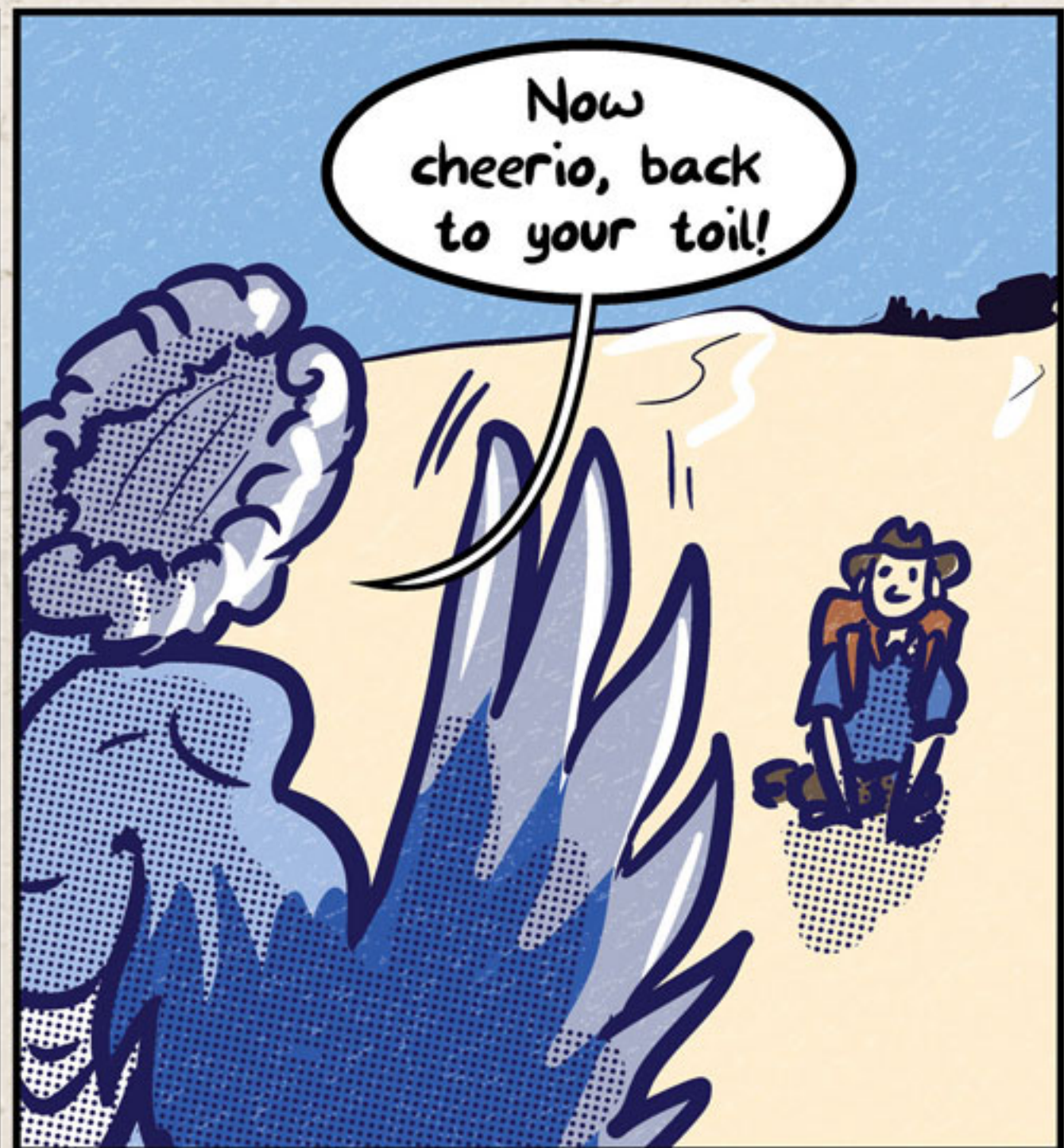
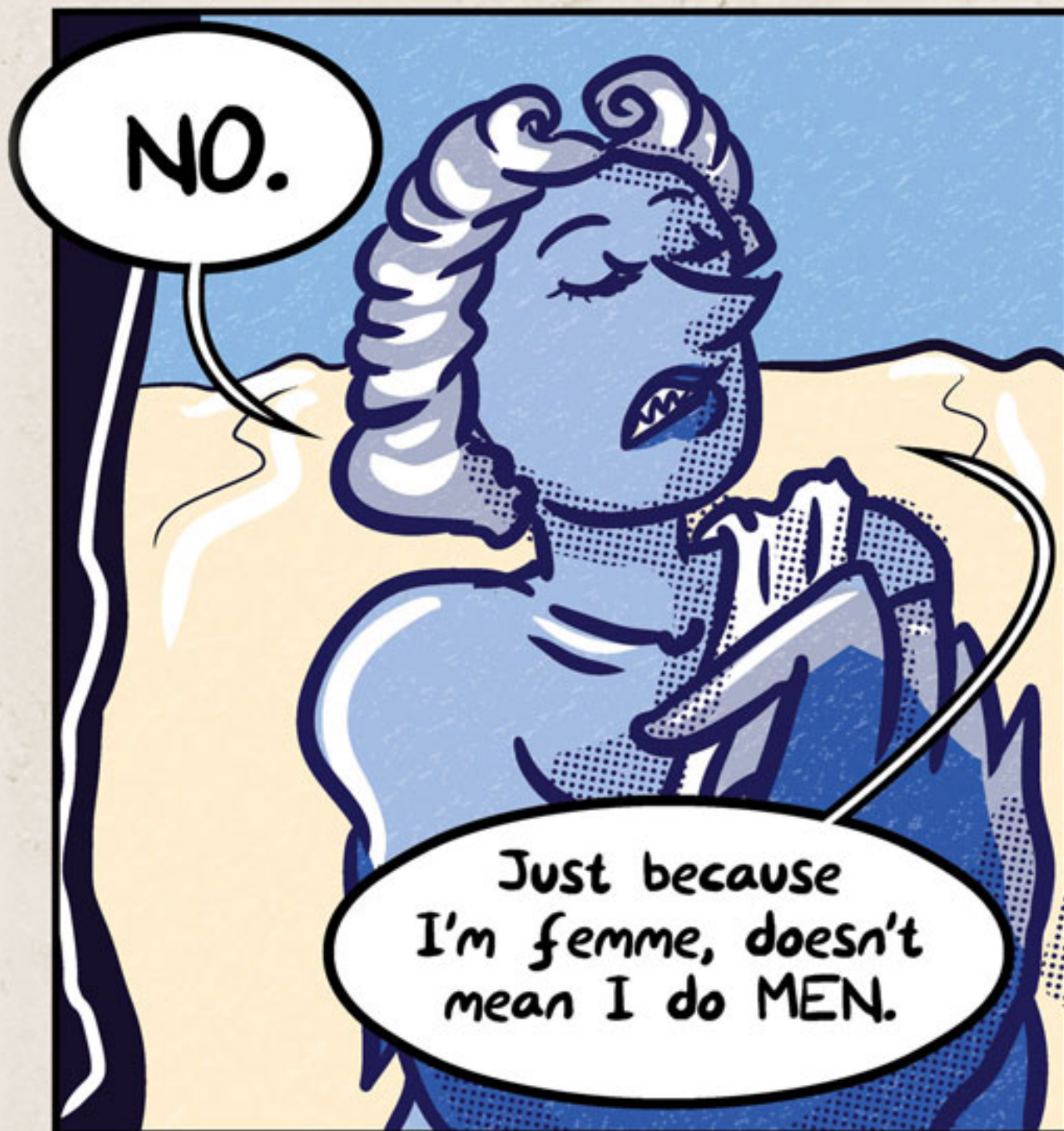
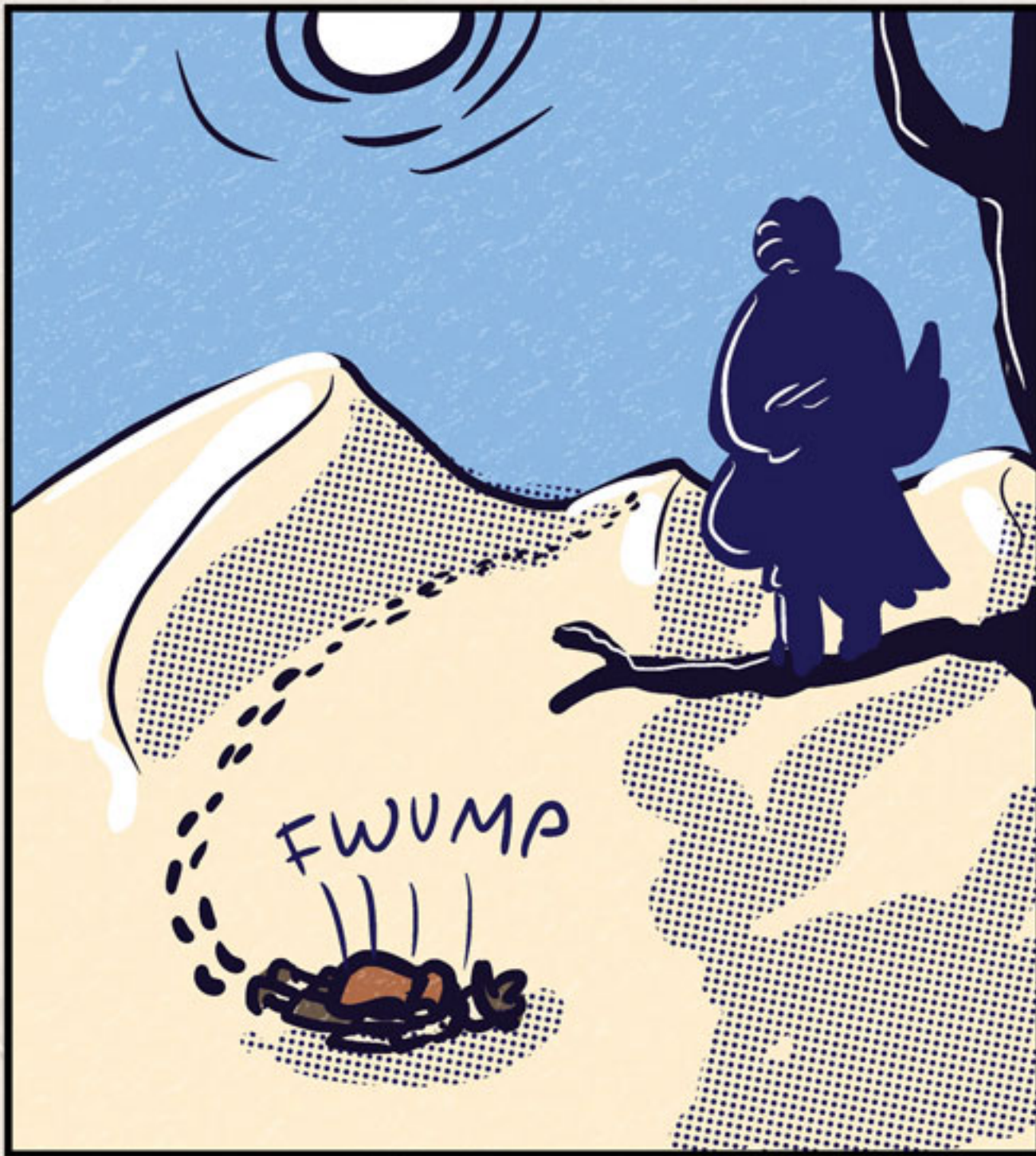
Some asexuals hate sex completely and consider themselves "Sex averse".

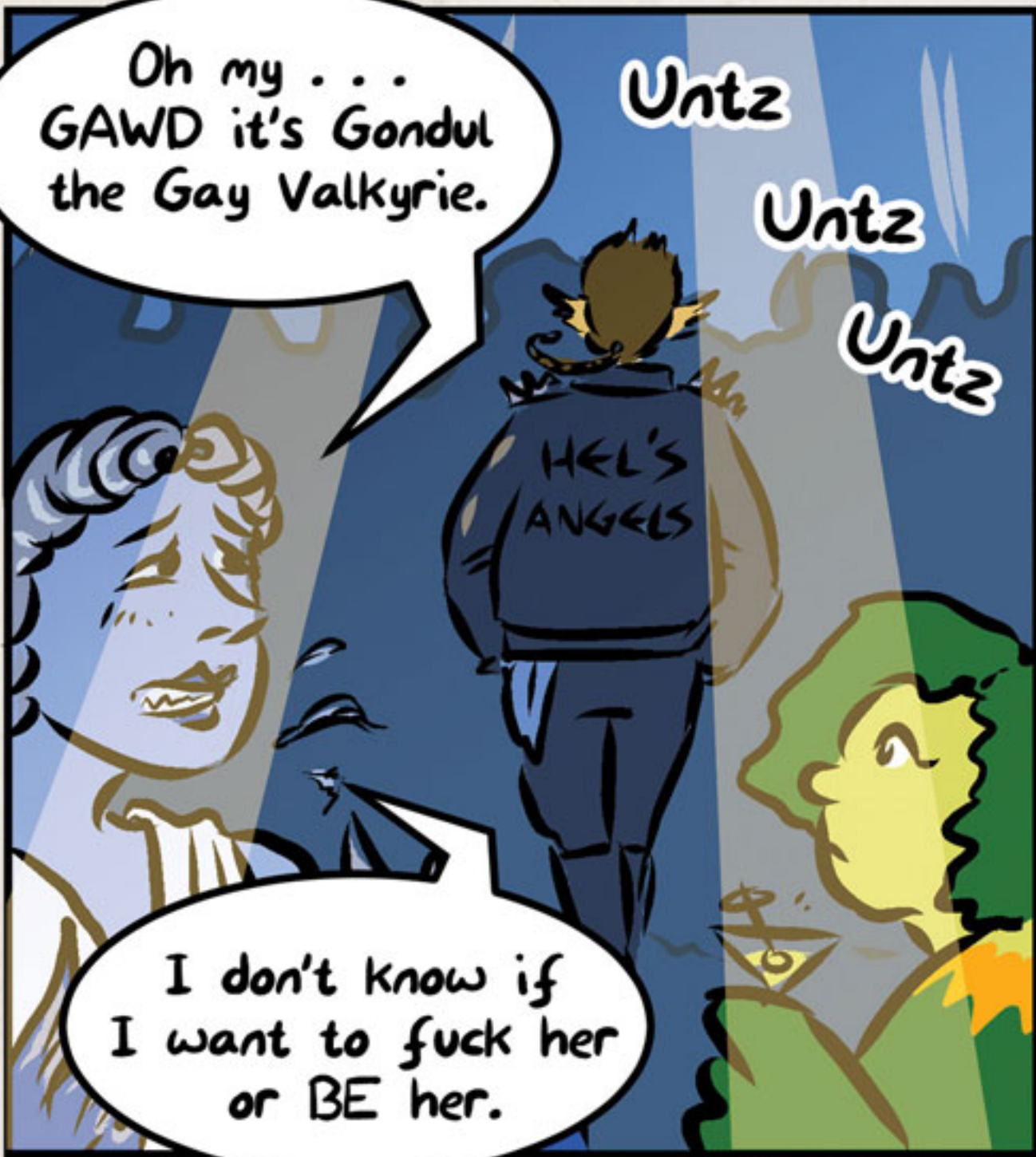

# GAYRIES VALKYRIES

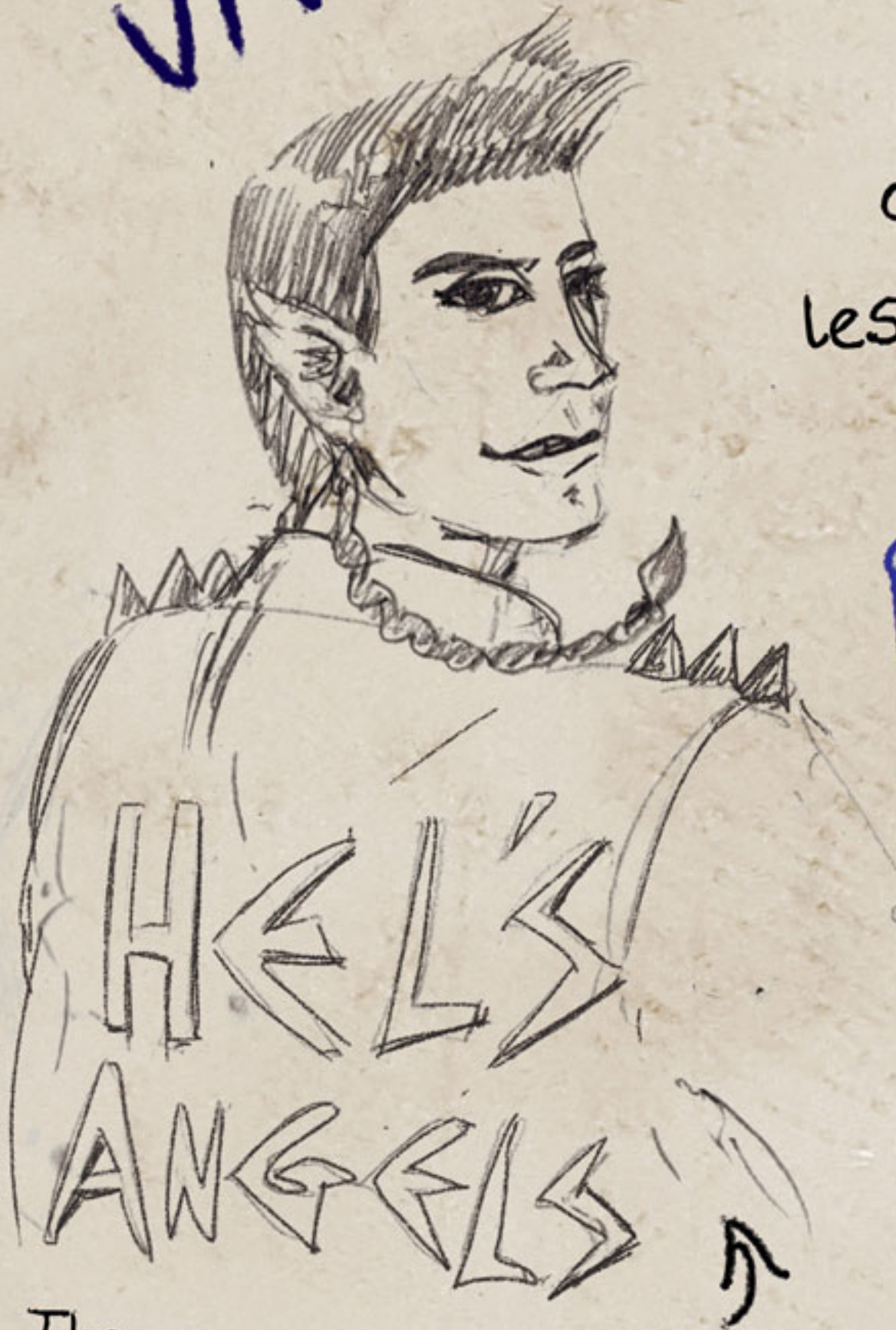
Originally means "carefree"

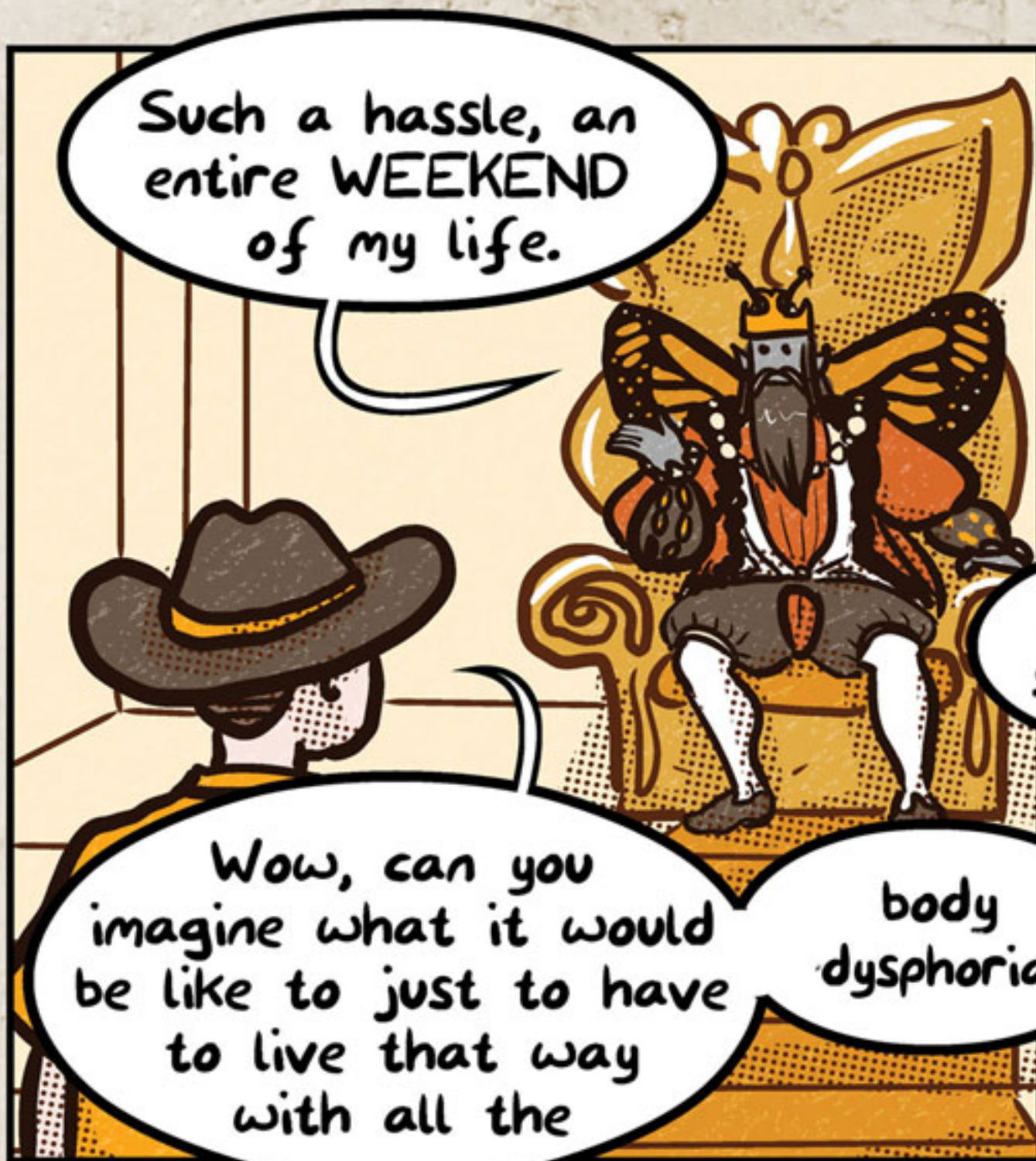

# TRANSGENDER

KINGS, QUEENS AND OTHER ROYALTY...

Transgender is an

umbrella term for anyone who has a gender identity different from their assigned sex.

This includes people who transition from male to female (or vice versa) as well as people who don't identify as either.

(but more on that later)

When they were born the doctor shouted "It's a girl!" but as they got older they started to realise it wasn't true.

King Monarch is open about growing up a princess, but many trans people are NOT and that should be respected.

Sometimes this is for safety reasons- trans people often get fired, harassed or are the subjects of violence.

Some people use transsexual to describe those who medically transition from one gender to the other, but this word is falling out of favour.



(Possibly because it makes it sound like a sex thing when it's actually about gender)

In the human realm about 1/1000 people identify as transgender.



Unfortunately non-magic folk can't just drink a potion to magically change how they look.

Instead, people use a combination of hormones, clothes and surgery to make their bodies match their minds.
