




BISexual UNICORNS


Bisexuals are attracted to their own gender AND to genders not their own

Bisexual started as a medical term between HETEROSEXUAL (opposite attraction) and HOMOSEXUAL (same attraction)



Bi doesn't necessarily mean TWO.
It's about something that BISECTS the other options

KINSEY SCALE OF SEXUALITY



This is called the Heterosexual to Homosexual CONTINUUM and is an early model used to describe sexuality outside of gay and straight


POLYAMORY & DRAGONS

Like the Dryad Triad




Sometimes one person has multiple partners




Sometimes things get more complicated





Some have a Don't ask, Don't tell policy with partners, some need to know more details.


HOMOSEXUAL


HETEROFLEXIBLE

Hippocampus




Sleek feather lines








(SATYRS, SATYRESSES AND FAUNS)

- * Pan people get hard frying eggs






Some asexuals do have sex, often because it pleases their partner.

(Like how some people can't stand mint chocolate chip cupcakes.)



Some asexuals are interested in romance, others are not.

TRANSGENDER KINGS, QUEENS AND OTHER ROYALTY.

Transgender is an

umbrella term for anyone who has a gender identity different from their assigned sex.

This includes people who transition from male to female (or vice versa) as well as people who don't identify as either.

(but more on that later)

When they were born the doctor shouted "It's a girl!" but as they got older they started to realise it wasn't true.

King Monarch is open about growing up a princess, but many trans people are NOT and that should be respected.

Sometimes this is for safety reasons- trans people often get fired, harassed or are the subjects of violence.


Some people use transsexual to describe those who medically transition from one gender to the other, but this word is falling out of favour.

(Possibly because it makes it sound like a sex thing when it's actually about gender)

In the human realm about 1/1000 people identify as transgender.

Unfortunately non-magic folk can't just drink a potion to magically change how they look.

Instead, people use a combination of hormones, clothes and surgery to make their bodies match their minds.
